High School Banquet

Ladies as you are beginning to shop for your dress for the banquet please remember the following dress code guidelines as stated in the handbook.



- Dresses must be modest.
- Dresses may not be strapless, even if a sweater is worn.
- A solid sweater/bolero jacket must be worn if the dress does not completely cover the back or shoulders. Wraps and shawls are not permitted.
- Dresses worn without a sweater must have at least a cap sleeve.
- Dresses may not be form fitting from the waist down (no mermaid-style).
- Necklines must be no lower than the width of three fingers from the hollow of the neck. See-through dresses must be lined to meet this standard. Wide necklines must be covered with a sweater.
- The hemline of dresses must reach the bottom of the kneecap. See-through dresses must be lined to meet this standard. Slits must not be any higher than the bottom of the kneecap.

All girls must have their dresses approved by the office no later than Monday, April 6th. (That is the Monday after spring break) Please do not take tags off the dress until it has been approved.
